# **Continued Prayer for Uganda**

Godfrey reported in the recent Presidential Address in Uganda that there are as many as 10 million people in Uganda who live from hand to mouth. The longer the lockdown stays in place, there is a danger the death toll from starvation will outnumber deaths due to COVID-19. Right now the current number of positive cases is of COVID-19 are 49. Please be in prayer for the majority of Ugandans who are faced with the possibility of having no food for their families.

The most recent update is the government is going to supply food for 1,500,000 families. They are also trying to empower short term food crops and also supplying seeds.
