# **Due to the generosity of donors, RAINING HOPE was able to help 10 families in our community with food this Christmas and 10 families of our children.** Many have continued to struggle. We provided food baskets of rice, beef, cooking oil, sugar, bread and butter. Godfrey said they saw what a difference a simple meal made and how the families praised God for the provision. Here are a few testimonies Godfrey sent from the thankful recipients.

## **Kenneth's Testimony**

"Kenneth is a young man in church serving as an usher living in our Ambercoart community. He welcomes visitors and takes people's temperature. We have been helping him as a church slowly because of the challenges they go through as a family. His father lost his job and since then they have been struggling. They have gone without food and paying house rent was a challenge. His mother sells sweet potatoes in the market but that income cannot sustain them. Before Christmas, Kenneth didn't know how his family would be able to celebrate. When I called him for the Christmas food gift, he was speechless for a minute and made a statement that God is faithful. I knew what that meant and I encouraged and shared God's love that is unending. He was so encouraged and praised God for His provision. I see him come around on Sunday and Friday with a smile. We give God praise."

## **Judith's Testimony**

"Judith is a youth leader associate in our church living in Ambercoart near our house. She is very supportive of her family. Her mother got sick and couldn't sustain the family even before she became ill due to her low income. This is one of the families we want to help in the future with micro financing to help start a business to supporter her family. They didn't know how they were going to celebrate Christmas due to the financial shortage. When they received the gift, it was a great encouragement to them! Joy filled their hearts and above all they knew they are loved and cared for by God. God is so good."

### **Another Testimony**



"We were able to help another one of our church members who lives in our neighborhood. He is the bread winner for his family. His mother and father divorced years ago. It was so challenging for him even to be in school. Recently he applied for a job which required going away for training. Unfortunately, some were subjected to harsh training that led to broken limbs and lost lives. A few decided to escape to the nearest town where he called me. As a church we sent him transport to come back home. On reaching home, he came to church and shared his testimony of what he endured and how thankful he was the church brought him home. He didn't know how he would celebrate on Christmas because his hope was on the allowance they would be given during the training. When we handed him the Christmas gift he got so emotional. He was so surprised and extremely grateful. Upon receiving the gift he said this wipes his pain away from the devastating situation he was in. I am taking him through healing process and praying with him. But I now see him with a smile on his face." (His name and specific details are being withheld to protect his

## PRAYER REQUESTS

## **Update:**

1. FOOD SUPPLY - The prices are still very high which has increased our monthly budget. For the last nine months we have been able to send Godfrey the full budget at the beginning of each month due to the generosity of all our supporters. Pray for the budget needs that we will be able to continue sending the full amount at the start of the month. Last month was close but we still were able to send the full budget!

Because of rising COVID cases and deaths they are facing a **possible lockdown.** Pray we will be prepared as this will affect the food supply not only for us but for the families of our immediate community and families of our students.

### 2. RADIO MINISTRY -

The radio ministry continues to have a **huge impact** on the local community and the nation. Through the gifts from three generous donors we have been able to cover the local radio program fees **through December 2020.** Continue to pray for the **monthly \$135** airtime fee for the local program. The National Radio program is at no charge.

- 3. SEWING PROJECT Now that we have the sewing machines, they have begun making some of their clothing. They are in need of purchasing material for their projects.
- **4. COMPLIANCE -** COVID-19 also stopped the process of our coming under compliance to receive our official license. Please be in prayer for the needed funds to finish projects and pay fees.
- **5. REMODEL OF KITCHEN** To come under compliance one of the areas we are required to complete is the remodel of the kitchen. We have a balance of \$247 to complete this project.
- **6. SCHOOL FEES** Pray for the necessary national **exam school fees and the internship fees.** More info will be in **part 2 of the January newsletter.**
- **7. VAN** The van is in need of repairs to the transmission. The cost for repair and labor will be approximately \$229.
- **8. ELECTRICAL & PLUMBING** Pray for various electrical and plumbing repairs needed at the house. Cost approximately \$63.

## PRAYERS FOR UGANDAN PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS

Please pray for Uganda as they had Presidential elections on Thursday, January 14, 2021. There has been widespread violence and deaths leading up to the elections. Incumbent President Yoweri Museveni was reelected for a sixth term.

Godfrey reported "He won the election by 58.6% higher than his follower with 34.8%. Even though many expected violence after elections by closing their shops and going to villages, the situation remained calm as police and army are deployed on the streets to combat crime. Keep praying for us as a nation between now and the inauguration of the president, May 14, 2021."
