Greeting Sponsors, Friends and Partners with Raining Hope:

We are so thankful for the continued support towards the education of our students. Those who began with us as young children in pre-school are now in university and other institutions of learning. We give God praise for using you that much in the lives of many. It is very difficult here to attain a proper education. Many students drop out of school due to lack of school fees. Uneducated children suffer a great deal of things in Uganda.

Having the opportunity to go to school in Uganda means they have a chance for their dreams to be fulfilled which means they have hope for a good future. We are all so thankful to all of you who help support our student's school fees.

Our students are now on a holiday break that will last for two weeks. We have some in candidate classes who will be preparing for the national examinations. They rest will be going back to school on May 2, 2022.

So much has changed with schools as far as where school fees and requirement are concerned. Almost everything has doubled in prices in terms of goods and services. When fuel prices go high, it affects everything because most of these items are transported with vehicles that require fuel. Most of our students remain in the boarding section as it is safe for them and helps them catch up and concentrate in school. This is the first time in our Raining Hope history that the school fees and requirements went UP for the second term instead of going DOWN.

Older Joan will be graduating this year from her University courses. This is her last semester at Kampala University Jinja branch. Her fees include school fees, transport, meals, materials, research, dissertation, report and graduation fees. We are so excited to have another student graduating from their advance courses!

We appreciate you joining us in prayer for the needed school fees & requirements. **This is a time sensitive issue as the registration process has already begun.** Godfrey has been working with the schools to register them while we wait on the necessary funds.

PRAYER REQUESTS/PRAISE

Update:

1. FOOD SUPPLY & FUEL:

The prices are still very high which continues to increase our monthly budget. There has been a rise in fuel prices that began even before the current situation in Ukraine. This causes an increase in the prices of goods and services because of the rise in transportation costs. Just in the last month, food prices have skyrocketed and almost doubled. Godfrey said that up until now they have not had to pay any taxes on any items. But now shops are beginning to require an 18% tax even on food. Because of the unexpected high cost for the 2nd term school fees, Godfrey said they are going to try to adjust and live within last month's budget which was \$2,323.

The **regular monthly budget** includes food, supplies, medical needs, utilities (water & electricity), transportation (petro) & needed repairs.

Godfrey said they have a saying in Uganda. Soap has gotten very expensive to buy. The saying Is that soap is now more expensive than a shirt. So you may have a shirt but no soap to wash it.

Please keep our monthly budget in your prayers.

2. SCHOOL FEES:

The school fees for the second term are due now. For the very first time, the second term is higher than the first term. It came as a surprise as it is always lower. Godfrey has been working with the schools to try and lower some of the costs. This is a widespread issue as the high costs due to the current economic situation is affecting all students and families. Please be in prayer for the needed school fees and requirements.

3. COMPLIANCE:

All faith-based and non-governmental organizations operating within the city of Jinja must re-register under the new compliance changes due to the city of Jinja incorporating. Godfrey is continuing to work closely with them to make sure we comply in all areas. We will update you with any other requirements.
