

For the past ten years, we have purchased one main Christmas gift for the whole family. Our students live together as a family. This is different from other organizations whose children don't live together under one roof. Godfrey is the one who will let me know what gift is most needed. Because we are focusing on getting budget needs caught up and school/university fees were so high, they were not expecting a family gift this year. They are grateful for their education and what they already have. **We definitely want to bless the family with a gift!** We will begin raising money this month. When I expressed this to Godfrey, he said they can wait until all funds are raised even if this means the gift will be purchased in the beginning of 2026.

There are various needs for the family. But the gift they would need the most is a **new refrigerator.** We bought a freezer awhile ago to help keep food for longer periods. But they go **shopping for perishables multiple times a week** because they don't have any way to keep things cold. A refrigerator will help them the most.

MONTHLY BUDGET

Pray for our monthly budget needs. Compliance issues, higher school fees and an increase in the monthly radio costs contribute to the monthly budget challenges.
