Our students are eternally grateful for the love and support you have shown throughout the last fifteen years to help them realize their dreams. It is happening and you have an important role in launching them into their careers!

The Resettlement Program helps the five students with rent, food and basic necessities for three months. They are not going to be far from our home. They will still be actively involved with the home and with our ministry. They just won't be living at the house. Raining Hope is their home and we are their family. Sylvia and Hillary have leadership responsibilities at church on Sunday. They will continue with their ministry service at Raining Hope Ministries. Jesca, Vivian and Joan will remain active at Raining Hope as well.

Sylvia is working at a salon as a makeup artist. She is still waiting on the right opportunity to apply her journalism skills. She graduated with a degree in Journalism.

Joan is graduating this summer with her degree in Social Work. We will employ her as our required social worker.

Jesca is working at Miracle Herbal Clinic in Jinja Town. She graduated with a degree in Nursing. **Hillary** is not yet working but plans on setting up a business in Wanyange to sell cloth while he waits on a ministry opportunity for his seminary degree. BEACON OF HOPE SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM



Over the past **fifteen years** we have helped countless students through their primary, secondary & post secondary school education. You have given in multiple ways:

- 1. A one time designated donation when a specific need arises.
- 2. Multiple designated donations as a regular supporter.
- 3. Becoming a Beacon of Hope Monthly Sponsor which is a minimum of \$30 a month. The monthly average per student to cover food, shelter, clothing, medicine, supplies etc. is closer to \$90 per month depending on the age of the student and their education level. But to make it affordable we set the minimum at \$30 a month so more people could be involved in sponsorship.

After the five students are resettled into their new homes, Raining Hope will have fifteen students we care for living under the same roof. All of the students in our home have had individual sponsors similar to many other Child Sponsorship Organizations. Instead of having multiple sponsors per child, we **shifted from a one-to-one child sponsorship program** to a **family sponsorship program.** In order to get to the heart of Raining Hope and our mission, this new model is the way **you can be more acquainted with all our students who are Raining Hope.** This has worked beautifully since we made that shift years ago.

Monthly Budget

Since the start of the pandemic, our monthly budget in Uganda has increased to an average of \$2,200 a month. This covers food, medical, salaries, transportation, clothing and other miscellaneous items. For the month of September the budget needs are \$2365.

• Additional needs for September:

• Computer Repair: \$82

• Ink Cartridges: : \$36

- Continue to pray as Godfrey is doing his best to live within the budget even though prices on everything are continuing to rise. The one area that can't be cut back is medical. He is trying to scale back and prioritize the food budget depending on the daily rising prices. LAST WEEK he told me that in one day many food prices doubled.
- Update from the recent protests in Kampala & Jinja:
 - Heavy deployment of police and the army helped to keep the protests under control. The protesters did not succeed.
 - The economy is still struggling. Commodity prices are high. People are dying of hunger.
 There is still a high crime rate.
 - Petro (fuel) remains high which sparks the continued rise in food costs and commodities.
 - In the recent Presidential address, he encouraged them to endure and adjust their way of living.
 - They are in the rainy season now. Planting of crops is happening. They expect food prices to come down towards December.
