#### Update on Eydie's Mom's Hospitalization:



Dear Friends,

My mom went to a boarding home care situation for about 21 days due to a problem with insurance. After two doctor's appointments on May 11th, she was approved to return to the Peninsula Post Acute facility because of her wounds that need daily care. We had 40 days left on her insurance. At this point we have about a month left. We are praying that her Medi-cal application will be approved that will help with long term care needs.

Mid June I am planning on transitioning back to Southern California and coming back to help with my parents. We will know more once we find out about Medi-cal. My travel schedule starts to pick back up and I will need to get back home.

This has been a sudden change for our family but filled with testimony after testimony of God's grace and mercy. ### Update on Renovation Needs by Priority

"The Town council officials came over and dropped off a letter that requires all houses within the city that are in bad shape to be worked on. Our house wasn't so bad but needs painting and a new roof and a drainage system." (Godfrey)

**Roof:** They said the roof is old and can cause damage to the house. Mold can also begin to grow. We have been experiencing rains which have exposed the weaker parts of the roof most especially in the kitchen area and the girl's corridor. The leakage around the kitchen is more worrisome because electricity cables are all around that place. This will require us to cover the main switch and work on the loose electric cables in that area as per the earlier electric repair budget. Meanwhile, we can close the leaking areas of the roof as we trust God for the whole repair so that it doesn't weaken and fall. **Approximate cost: \$4974** 

**Painting:** The boy's quarters and the main building both need painting. We were waiting to do this the same time as the roof. Now it is a requirement by the town council.

Approximate cost for boy's quarters inside and out: \$1,026 Approximate cost for main building inside and out: \$1,957

**Drainage System:** Water goes into the neighborhood and floods towards the wall and goes next door to our neighbor's property. We made a hole in the wall to go to the other side. But we need to create a way for the drainage to go to the road to the main drainage system. **Approximate cost: \$1,195** 

**New Sign Post:** We need a "Raining Hope" sign post for our property. We have needed one for quite some time. We will have less issues with the town council with a sign outside our property that shows we are a ministry. **Approximate cost: \$222** 

**Internet :** We have internet service at the house but it is in need of an upgrade. Many times the connection is poor and Godfrey has to go to the hotel to communicate with me. For us to install a better system it will be approximately \$155. Monthly the cost is \$15 (can you believe it?!).

Additional Renovation Needs:	
Electrical repairs: \$366	Plumbing: \$1318

Rain Water Harvest Tank: \$1,068

We have been praying for these renovation needs. Due to the new regulations which are helping to keep organizations accountable, the above have moved to a high priority. **Our goal is to raise \$15,000** (Above add up to \$12,281 which are approximate costs & are calculated at a 3600 exchange rate. The goal will cover unexpected costs, additional expenses and legal fees). We have launched a special fundraiser on our "YouCaring" website that we used to raise the funds for the purchase of the house in 2015. #### PRAY FOR CONTINUED FINANCIAL NEEDS

#### SCHOLARSHIPS

We have two in nursing school, one in seminary, one in broadcasting school and two in computer classes to prepare for their post secondary school education.
