
Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving; let us *shout joyfully* to Him with psalms." Psalms 93:2

We are so thankful for all we accomplished when we were faced with the **initial compliance requirements.** This was due to your immediate response. We still have more to do.

We were given a reprieve due to the wedding, introduction and graduation activities. Many other homes were immediately shut down who were not in compliance. Some from the board were in attendance for our graduation so they saw in action what we are all about. That bought us some time but **now we are needing to complete the first phase of compliance to receive the official permit to operate.** 

But, like last time, we have been given very short notice that the compliance officials from Kampala are coming. They are making their rounds this Friday, November 24, 2023 to the Jinja area for one week. Our house will be one visited. Godfrey was caught by surprise by the information.

Currently, the amount needed for **this phase of compliance & the year end Auditing & Filing Tax Returns is \$1840**. Every organization in Uganda is required to pay the Auditing & Filing Tax Returns fee. We file at the end of every year. This is an **immediate need as the surprise inspection is happening within days.** We are so thankful for all who have given so far that has **kept us open to this point.** Unfortunately, as rules keep changing, we need to comply in order to keep operating.

We accomplished so much in a short time in order to initially comply. We appreciate your prayers as we continue to complete all that is needed. There is so much more to do in the lives of our Raining Hope family. Continue to pray for the necessary funds for compliance so we can continue to operate.
