For awhile now, his computer has been a challenge. He continues to have it repaired but it is just delaying the inevitable. Godfrey sacrifices to make sure the needs of the family are first met. The last three years we have been dealing with a **budget that increases every month due to COVID lockdowns and food prices doubling.** So as part of our **VIRTUAL FUNDRAISER** I would love to raise the funds to **purchase Godfrey a new computer.** He has not asked for this so I want it to be a Christmas surprise. The cost is around \$650-\$700. It is best to raise the money and let him buy a new one there. I know we can get better deals here but since I am not traveling to Uganda this New Year's Eve and shipping costs would be too high, it is best to allow him to purchase it there. Our work together is dependent upon a working computer.







FAMILY CHRISTMAS GIFT & CHRISTMAS/NEW YEAR'S MEAL

For the past seven years, we have purchased one main Christmas gift for the whole family. Our children live together as a family. This is different from other organizations whose children don't live together under one roof.

As a family, Godfrey said this year the gift that would mean the most would be **much needed mattresses** for each family member.

The cost: \$978 for mattresses and transporting to the house. (\$51 per Raining Hope family member)
Annual Christmas/New Year's Meal & Party for the family: \$137



HELPING FAMILIES THIS CHRISTMAS

RAINING HOPE would like to bless 20 families with food this Christmas. This will be for the families of our children and a few in our community. Many families have struggled during the pandemic. . We would provide **food baskets** of rice, beef, cooking oil, sugar, bread, soap, salt & fuel. We also want to provide enough to carry them through the New Year.

The cost: \$832 or \$42 per family.

Tuesday, November 29, 2022 was #GivingTuesday2022, a global day dedicated to giving back. Year End Audit & Tax Returns (In Uganda)

Every organization in Uganda is required to pay for **Auditing & Filing Tax Returns.** Godfrey was reminded of this by the Uganda Revenue Authority because we were going to be penalized for a late return. He was able to receive an extension that needs to be paid before the end of December. It is for both **2021 & 2022** since COVID19 lockdown **delayed all payments.**

TOTAL COST due by end of December 2022: \$822
