Mission Week Update

Raining Hope Ministries planned a Mission's Week from May 15-21, 2017. The purpose of this mission was to reach the unsaved in our community. We originally wanted to have an event across the bridge at the Nile grounds but we had to change strategy due to those who let us down with the stage we were to rent. Because our intent was to reach the lost, we still chose to go door-to-door for a two-on-one mission's strategy. This strategy simply was two people meet one person and preach the gospel to them, pray with them and invite them for a Love Sunday which is May 21, 2017. We had our children of Raining Hope joined by other members of the church take the lead in this mission of God.

Mission Strategy:

May 8-14. 2017: We had one week of prayer and preparation which ended well and empowered our children. God is using our children for His glory.

May 15-17, 2017: Reaching the community around us preaching the gospel. In these three days we had 77 encounters, 38 people gave their lives to Christ and 15 renewed their relationship with Christ! All were invited to join us for Love Sunday. I was glad in the spirit to see even the most fearful reach out to the lost. To me that was a breakthrough. Nothing was as interesting to me as to watch our children speak to people about the love of Christ and share their testimonies.

May 18-19, 2017: Follow up for those who gave their lives to Jesus. We were able to follow up with 20 people. Eleven of those came to our Bible study on Friday night. Many others promised to attend Love Sunday.

May 20, 2017: We committed this Saturday to pray for those who gave their lives to Christ and for those who we found with problems during the outreach. We also prayed in preparation for Love Sunday.

LOVE SUNDAY - May 21, 2017:

Every last Sunday of the month we dedicate to a **Love Sunday**. **This Sunday**, **May 21st**, **is designed for seekers**. We have food and/or tea depending on what we can raise. The service is organized in such a way that it is mission oriented. The choir, program leader, children's Sunday School, and praise and worship are designed to evangelize during the service. We chose songs with the intention of reaching out to those who come during the service. We prepare church members to show love to those who come. The Raining Hope choir will sing. Hillary will lead the program as usual. Vivian will lead the ushering & welcoming of people. Irene will teach the children in Sunday School. Older Joan and Sylvia will lead the music as other church members are also involved. **Through such a service we expect:**

1. To minister to the seekers and see many turn to the Lord. 2. Show the love of Christ to the hurting world. 3. Unite as a family as we break bread together. 4. Pray for the sick, hurting and discouraged in life. 5. Bring back hope to the people through the ministry of the Word.

On April 18, 2017, I attended a lunch meeting of the Duarte Kiwanis Club to accept a donation & share a few words about our work in Uganda. Pastor Doug Spriggs & Stafford Barker of Grace Fellowship were instrumental in speaking to this club about what God is doing at Raining Hope. Pastor Doug introduced me to the group in attendance. Something that he said confirmed the heart of who we are as Raining Hope:

"One of the things I love about Raining Hope is their approach to building lifelong followers of Jesus. Rather than trying to make a small difference in many lives, Raining Hope is making a huge difference in a few lives. They are serving a select group of people in a very profound way, that will lead to generational transformation for countless others. To put it simply, Raining Hope is going deep, not wide.

This is the discipleship strategy of Jesus. Just as He invested deeply in the lives of a few key disciples, so Raining Hope is investing deeply in the lives of one large family of kids. These kids are being raised to be world-changers and they are already making a difference in the lives of others.
