## Mission's Month Update!



Thank you for your prayers during the Mission's Month for Raining Hope! Here is an initial report from Godfrey of what they saw God do this month:

The Ministry of Education shifted the second term school schedule which affected our program. Their exams were set on the same dates we were suppose to have the open air evangelism. The week of prayer was affected because it was suppose to involve the students so attendance was low.

They made the decision to postpone the open air evangelism and the door to door evangelism to the next term holiday because of the unexpected change in school schedule and the lack of the needed funds.

The Youth Conference went on as scheduled. The first day they had 120 youth attend. The second day it increased to 150 youth. The third day there were 160 youth in attendance! Over 20 youth were filled with the Holy Spirit and many were delivered. They provided lunch for everyone on all three days. Godfrey invited two guest pastors to help teach in the conference. Some of the leaders in the church led Bible study groups during the youth workshops. The second day of the conference came with showers of rain which also came as a blessing!

They completed the month of outreach with a worship service on Sunday, September 1st. They had over 240 people come for worship and seven recommitted their lives to Christ! The challenge was not having enough chairs for everyone to sit. They are still raising money as a church to buy more chairs. But God is using Raining Hope Ministries to reach out to the community in a powerful way! The past three months have been difficult for many in the Ambercoart Community due to the high cost of living in the country. Two of our church leaders, Emma & Clair had to move out of Ambercoart because of pressures from their landlord. Pray for our Raining Hope family during this season. Pray for Godfrey as he continues to visit families in our community to encourage and pray with them.

Our monthly budget in Uganda is approximately \$1700. This is separate from school fees and renovation needs. This covers food, medical, salaries, transportation, clothing and other miscellaneous items. We are trying to raise \$2,000 so we can get ahead one month to send the full amount at the start of the month. We currently have to send the money for the budget two separate times in the month which makes it more challenging for daily operations. The additional \$300 would be for an emergency fund they can keep there on hand for unexpected expenses.

**Second Term School Fees:** We still have a balance of \$300 to complete the second term fees.
