

In Depth Praise - December 11, 2022



As we mark the end of this year, Raining Hope is organizing an **In-Depth Praise service on December 11, 2022.** The In-Depth praise is birthed out of the series Godfrey has been teaching on praising God. They shall invite other ministries to join them as we wind up the year in joyful praise unto our God.

They are also planning to have our end of year celebrations as a ministry on New Year's Eve. Currently that will be just for our family.

When we were making plans for both events, it was **all dependent upon the Ebola outbreak.** They have to have special permission to plan the event. That is why we had not planned to have a community

event for New Year's Eve. It is also why I postponed going to Uganda at the end of this year due to the Ebola outbreak. We didn't know what the status would be with containment of the virus.

We are thankful to God who continues to protect the family against Ebola. But as cases have declined it looks like it will be safe to proceed with the current plans. Ebola virus has moved away from Jinja. Those places where Ebola is still a threat are under quarantine. That is why they are cleared to have the In-Depth session with observance of the preventive measures. Please continue to pray as they seek wisdom and discernment to safely have the event.

EBOLA OUTBREAK

On September 20, 2022, the health authorities in the Republic of Uganda declared an **outbreak of Ebola disease** caused by Sudan ebolavirus (SUDV), after a case was confirmed in a village in Madudu sub-county in Mubende district, central Uganda on September 19, 2022. The ongoing outbreak of Sudan Ebolavirus in Uganda is **showing signs that transmission may now be under control.** This is a report as of Monday, November 28, 2022 by Uganda's Ministry of Health.

Cases have continued to decline according to World Health Organization situation reports and only six active cases are currently being treated in specialized Ebola treatment units. In the current outbreak, fifty-six people have died and eighty have recovered.

The lockdowns in the affected areas – which include a dusk-to-dawn curfew, a ban on personal travel, and the closure of markets, bars and churches – are scheduled to be **lifted on December 17** if no new cases are found.

To prevent a resurgence the Ministry of Health must remain vigilant and surveillance will need to continue at least through the end of the year.

Godfrey said the village in the Mubende district is about a 5 hour drive from us. **The virus did reach our area of Jinja and a death was recorded.**

Thank you for joining us in prayer during this Ebola outbreak. Our family remained diligent in staying safe. They are thankful to God for the protection against COVID 19 and the Ebola virus.

Monthly Budget

- Since the start of the pandemic, our monthly budget in Uganda has increased to an average of \$2,500 a month. This covers food, medical, salaries, transportation, clothing and other miscellaneous items. For the month of December the budget needs are \$2594.
- Our budget for medical is still high. In November the budget needs were \$447. Godfrey also reported that **Almecca**, the hospital we have used for years was sold and currently closed for renovations. We now use City Medical Care which will take time to build a good relationship with.
- Continue to pray as Godfrey is doing his best to live within the budget even though **prices on everything are continuing to rise.** The one area that can't be cut back is medical. **He is trying to scale back and prioritize the food budget depending on the daily rising prices.**
- Over this past year, each month the budget has slowly increased. Since the beginning of the pandemic, the monthly budget has gone from \$1,700 a month to over \$2,500 a month. We are thankful the Lord has provided in ways that can only be explained by Him. Pray for us to be able to continue sending the full budget at the beginning of each month.
